

NOTES FOR MEMBERSHIP APPLICANTS

Applicants for Membership of the Christchurch Sailing Club are reminded that the object of the Club, as set out in Rule 1, is:

***“the encouragement of yacht sailing and racing especially
in Christchurch Harbour and Bay“***

The General Committee will, therefore, only consider applicants who are prepared to actively and regularly participate in activities that further the object of the Club.

All Members are expected to assist in race management or escort duties once or twice a year.

The Club relies heavily on voluntary assistance from the Members and new Members, who have the time and/or particular expertise, will be encouraged to contribute.

Boat ownership is not mandatory and applications from those wishing to crew are welcome.

Membership categories are “Single”, “Family 2” and “Family 3”. “Family 3” membership includes any number of children over the age of 8 and up to and including 23 years of age. Three or more adults in a family require separate applications.

Applicants will submit the Attached Application Form, which should include a Proposer and Seconder. Applicants without a proposer may be considered on a trial basis. Applicants will be invited to the Club with their Proposer for an interview with Members of the General Committee. In the case of Family applications, adult applicants should attend together for interview. Applications will be considered formally at the next General Committee meeting.

All Applicants will be informed of the General Committees decision and those who are successful will be asked to complete a questionnaire detailing areas of voluntary help in which they may wish to participate.

Associate Members: Newly elected applicants are accepted as Associate Members for one year. As an Associate Member you will be required to keep a verifiable written record of all sailing activities and Club duties undertaken, which at the end of one year must be submitted to the Committee in support of your application for Full membership.

Full Members: Transfer to full Membership will be dependant on the Associate Member’s support for the Club’s activities during the year. Proposers may be requested to provide information on the Associate Member’s participation. The Committee may delay transfer of an Associate to Full Membership. If an Associate Member fails to further the Object of the Club the Committee may within the Rules terminate the membership.

Applicants are advised that there are currently waiting lists for cruiser moorings, cruiser storage and for dinghy storage.
