



# Christchurch Sailing Club

## Conditions for use of the Club Quayside & Pontoon

### General

- Please moor with consideration for others and so as to maximise the restricted space available.
- All conditions apply to Visitors and Members except where specified below.
- **Overnight Fees** are payable by Visitors and Members (see below)
- **Max Stay: 48 Hours** on the pontoon – (Extended stays may be possible on vacant moorings or on the quay wall during quieter periods but permission from a club officer must be obtained)

### Berth allocation

- **Pontoon facilities** are restricted to mono hull sailing boats; please moor clear of the white line. Priority for available space will be given to yachts under 10m long from recognised sailing/yacht clubs. Visitors should use the east side of the pontoon unless directed elsewhere by the club staff or a club officer.
- **Motorboat, Ribs and Multi hulled craft** may only use that part of the quay between the slipway and wooden ramp for short day-time visits. Except by prior agreement with a Club Officer or when involved in an organised Club event. **Visiting motor boat skippers must be members of an RYA affiliated club.**

### Facilities

- Electric & Wi-Fi is included in mooring rates.
- Please use the 24-hour toilet located at rear of Clubhouse or the main club facilities.
- **CCTV** Monitoring and Recording is in operation for the protection of members and visitors

### Tenders

- Only tenders are permitted on the concrete pontoon in front of the Long Boatshed.
- Tenders may not be stored alongside the Club pontoon / quay so as to obstruct use of the pontoon or quayside by yachts, Club tenders must be returned to the pontoon in front of the Long Boatshed.

### Exceptions to fees for CSC Members

- CSC Members arriving or departing to/from a sea passage between 8pm and 8am may stay alongside the quay wall (preferably between the two slipways) Free of Charge. *Fees are payable at all times when mooring overnight on the pontoon.*
- CSC Members doing a security patrol, or an early Race Officer duty, may lie alongside during the night. Free of Charge. Please obtain a ticket from the Steward.
- CSC Members may use the wall between the slipway and wooden ramp for essential repairs/maintenance for up to 48 hours Free of charge, all use must be recorded on arrival in the Maintenance Record Book located in the passage way leading to the sailing office/archive room. Longer stays for essential emergency repairs only must be authorised by a club officer.

Up to 7m .....	£12.00
Up to 9m .....	£15.00
9-11m .....	£20.00
Above 11m and by special permission .....	£25.00
Visiting Catamarans are not encouraged due to space constraint but if permitted .....	£25.00
Visitors Short Stay Rate (Lunchtime etc.) .....	£6.00
Motorboats are only allowed if we have little demand on space and can moor on the maintenance bay, (rates as per yachts)
