

## Junior and Pirates Week 2017

Junior and Pirates Week takes place from Monday 21<sup>nd</sup> – Friday 25<sup>th</sup> August.

All participants have to be Junior or Family members and have a completed medical declaration/ consent form otherwise entries cannot be accepted. Due to the popularity of the week we may have to limit numbers.

### Junior Week Info:

There will be 2 - 3 races each day with a short break for lunch/snacks. Sailors will be assigned to Gold, Silver or Bronze fleets by the race organisers. Sailors must have their own boat.

### Pirates Week Info:

Pirates will be having fun on the water each day with some informal instruction and games. Unlike Friday pirates a boat will be required for this week and a maximum of 2 Pirates per Oppie. **You need to arrange your boat and your Pirate crews in advance.** Due to the large quantity of sailors the event leaders are not able to assist with boat and crew problems during Pirates Week.

### General info:

Please can you make sure that your Junior is adequately dressed for the week and has a buoyancy aid. Please provide your Junior with lunch/snacks and drinks each day (**MUST be labelled and empties collected at the end of each day**), plenty of warm layers and, sun-cream and a hat. Parents or responsible adult are responsible for ensuring their children have boats and that their boats are in good working order, are ready to use and clearly labelled and have been checked prior to the week by one of the Coaching or Parent Helper team in Red Polo's. Monday morning is **NOT** a good time to find you are missing something! Sailors who are not properly prepared or equipped will be sent home.

We aim to be afloat for up to 4 hours each day and cannot bring sailors home early except in emergencies. Please ensure boats are returned to their racks or spaces each day after sailing. The club will be busy please be considerate towards other members when parking and moving boats around the club. The main club car park will be closed to parents throughout the week and reserved for organisers and club staff.

A parent or responsible adult will be expected to be at the club until the respected fleet launches. In the event of a cancellation or early finish a parent or responsible adult needs to be available for each child. We will endeavour to inform you in advance if our plans have to change. Parents or responsible adults must be on hand to collect and supervise their own children as soon as we return to shore at the given time shown below. This event is only possible due to volunteers giving their time, and precious annual leave, free of charge. Whilst we have our core event leaders organised, more help is needed on and off the water.
